



## 2018 City of Butler Trash and Recycling Service Information from Waste Management

We are excited to announce that the City of Butler has decided to contract with Waste Management as the exclusive trash and recycling hauler for residents.

### Collection Day

Please reference the attached street listing for your service day. Garbage and Recycling are picked up on the same day, but the day of the week depends on the street that you live on. Waste Management picks up trash throughout the week in the City of Butler. All items must be placed at the curb no later than 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled day of collection to avoid interrupted service.

### 2018 Service Information

#### Level 1 Service

Residents will be billed every three months in advance of the service period. This service provides once a week collection of solid waste (limited to seven 42-gallon containers and/or bags) and one bulk item per week for each residential unit. This service level includes unlimited recyclables collection every other week. Recycling is mandatory in the City of Butler.

#### Level 2 Senior Program

Residents will be billed every three months in advance of the service period. This service is exclusively offered to Senior Citizens and provides once a week collection of one 42-gallon plastic bag or one 42-gallon container, along with one bulky waste item per week. This service level includes unlimited recyclables collection every other week. Recycling is mandatory in the City of Butler.

**Senior Citizen: Residents 65 years of age or older, who are property owners on record.**

## Restricted Items

The following items will not be collected as part of the regular waste and recycling collection.

- Construction/demolition materials
- Automotive parts
- Household hazardous wastes (paint, oil, flammables, hot ash, etc.)
- Dirt, stone, concrete, rock
- Medical wastes
- Materials from fires or evictions
- Tires
- Pesticides/insecticides
- Antifreeze
- Electronics

## Recycling

Recycling will be collected every other week. See the attached calendar for your recycling week.

Great things happen when residents use **Recycle Often. Recycle Right.<sup>SM</sup>** program. By recycling everyday items like those shown below, raw materials, time, energy and money are saved. Plus the recycled materials become new products - if you recycle an aluminum can today, it could be back on the shelf as a new one in 60 days - and the cycle continues.

- Place only the acceptable recyclables shown in the attached poster in your recycling cart or bin - no sorting needed.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Do not bag your recyclables - empty recycling directly into your bin or cart.

**RECYCLE RIGHT:**

Things you can do to ensure quality material is recycled:



**DO NOT INCLUDE: Food waste, plastic bags, or polystyrene foam cups & containers**

Paper and cardboard must be dry and free of food debris.

Paper food containers must be rinsed out, no caps.

Tissues, paper towels or other paper that has been in contact with food is not acceptable.

Make sure food contamination and caps are removed from cans and plastics and all containers are empty.

Separate plastic lids from plastic bottles (often made from different materials)

Keep medical waste (syringes, needles) out of recycling containers or place in safe disposal containers like Waste Management's MedWaste Tracker® box.
