On May 7<sup>th</sup> Butler City Council voted to follow the Governor's Red – Yellow – Green rules for the opening of the City's park system. With Butler County's move into the Green phase, the following guidelines will be in effect starting today, June 5<sup>th</sup> May 25<sup>th</sup>. These guidelines are based on the latest recommendations of the Pennsylvania Recreation and Parks Society (May 23<sup>rd</sup>) who developed them with guidance from the PA Department of Health and Governor Wolf's Process to Reopen Pennsylvania.

- 1. All playgrounds are open.
- 2. Parks are open for walking and biking with social distancing of 6 15 feet.
- 3. Picnic shelters are available for use but individuals should continue to maintain social distancing.
- 4. The skate park is open with a maximum number of individuals of 90.
- 5. Basketball courts are open for games with a maximum number of individuals of 40 per court.
- 6. Games are now permitted on baseball, softball and football fields at Father Marinaro, Whippo Avenue and Memorial Park with no more than 90 individuals in attendance, including spectators.
- 7. Tennis courts are open for single and doubles play with a 15-minute buffer between groups of participants.
