Glass* Glass is repurposed, not recycled according to PA DEP's definition	Clear, brown, amber and green beverage bottles and food jars	Broken glass, light bulbs, dishes, drinking glasses, crystal, window glass, mirrors, ceramics, Pyrex or tempered glass	Rinse bottles and jars Do not break glass (labels may be left on)
Metal Cans	EMPTY food & beverage cans	aluminum foil, cans containing food, clothes hangers, scrap metal, screws, nails, toys, lawn furniture, paint cans, aluminum siding	Empty and rinse cans crush if need space Please push lid down inside of can
Plastics (PET, HDPE) Stamped #1 , #2 and #5 on bottom	Plastic containers #1, #2 and #5 on bottoms. Clear and green plastic soda bottles, Milk and water jugs, liquid detergent, bleach and softener bottles, hair care bottles	Plastic containers #7, Styrofoam peanuts and blocks, plastic plant pots, foam plastic egg cartons, plastic wrap, bubble wrap, plastic bags (loose nor bundles), CD & DVD's, toys, lawn furniture, motor oil, cooking oil, herbicide, antifreeze containers	Rinse container (crush if space is needed)
Paper, Newsprint & Magazines	News Paper, Magazines, phonebooks, catalogs, office and computer paper	colored wrapping paper	Place loose in bin Place heavy items on top DO NOT PUT PAPER OUT ON WET DAYS
Cardboard	Clean Corrugated & Pressed Cardboard Cartons (moving & shipping boxes, such as TV, computer, large appliance, boxes, etc.)	milk cartons, juice boxes, take-out food containers) oily, soiled or contaminated pizza boxes or cardboard	Flatten or break down into pieces no larger 4 feet. Remove all packing material Place in, under or beside the bin DO NOT PUT OUT ON WET DAYS!

^{*}Glass will be collected in your recycling bin from your municipality to be repurposed for another use

HOLIDAYS: We close in observance of the following holidays

New Year's Day Memorial Day Independence Day Labor Day Thanksgiving Day Christmas Day

If your collection day falls <u>ON OR AFTER A WEEKDAY HOLIDAY</u>, your collection will be 1 day later. If your collection day falls <u>BEFORE A WEEKDAY HOLIDAY</u>, there will be no change in your pickup.
