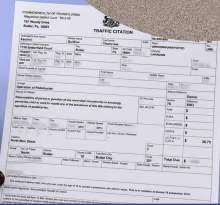

If your child breaks the law YOU may be facing the consequences

THE CONSEQUENCES ARE REAL

- Points on driving record
- Increased insurance cost
- Injury or death
- Fines
- Court



What can you ride?

- Bicycles
(Any age, can ride on roadways. Helmets required for anyone under 12 years old)
- Legal e-bikes
(16+ years old, must meet all criteria required by law, follow all traffic laws)
- Moped/Scooter/Motorized Bike
(16+ years old, requires class C license, registration, insurance, inspection, must wear a helmet if under 21 years old)

Restrictions on E-Bikes

- Must follow all traffic laws
- Must have operable pedals
- Must weigh less than 100 pounds
- Max speed of 20mph on motor alone
- Allowed on roadways
- Lights required at night
- Must be 16 years of age
- Motor can be no greater than 750 watts

(No license, insurance or registration required)



Electric Scooters

Not permitted on public roadways

- No operator training
- No insurance available
- No license or registration available
- Danger to traffic and pedestrians

(Under Pennsylvania law, electric scooters are NOT legal for use on public streets, roads, sidewalks or bike lanes)
